Thank you and well done to everyone who took part in the themed cake making. They all looked brilliant and I'm sure they were fun to make.


Year 2 have continued to take part in the Military School activities and the children in Reception have been busy looking after ducklings! Year I have been busy finding out about different flowers and plants.
