Some of you may have heard in the news that there could be strike action by teachers (following a national ballot of members).

The intended dates for those strike days, **if they go ahead**, would be:

I am awaiting further advice from the Local Authority on Monday and from the unions.

Our intention is to remain open to the children, however if a significant number of staff are not in school then we would need to assess the situation and may need to close some classes or the school on Health and Safety grounds.
