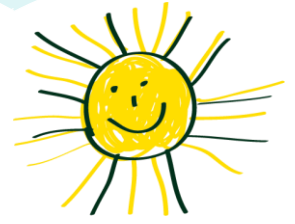
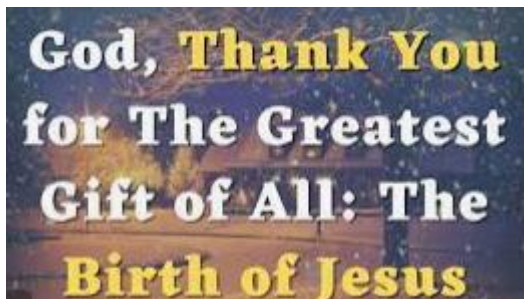


St Andrew's C of E Infant School Newsletter December 2023
