Key Vocabulary

Teen numbers, counting, forwards, backwards, repeating patterns, addition, add, subtraction, take away, part/part/whole, compare, order, total, equals, same

Practice adding and taking away using toys. Give your child simple challenges. You have 5 teddies, can you find 4 more? How many do you have altogether? You have 8 cars, can you take away 4? How many are left? Practice counting forwards and backward from any number within 20, e.g. start counting forwards from 9. Start counting backwards from 16.

Music

Physical Education
