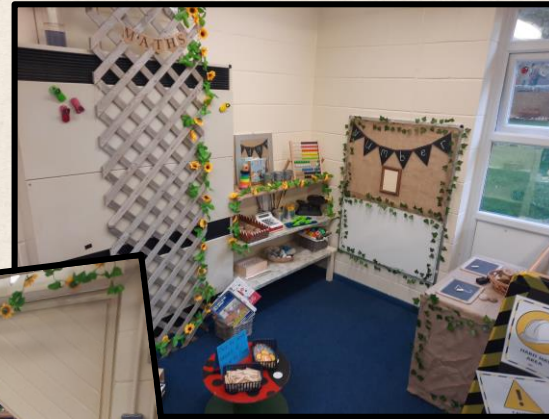
Our hall is the heart of school, with all classes leading from it

Plus an outdoor classroom where we can work as a small group, as well as water, music and maths areas

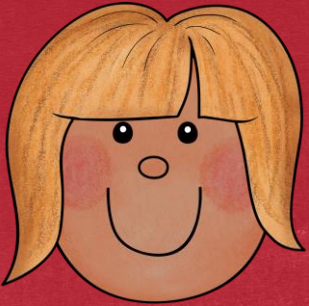

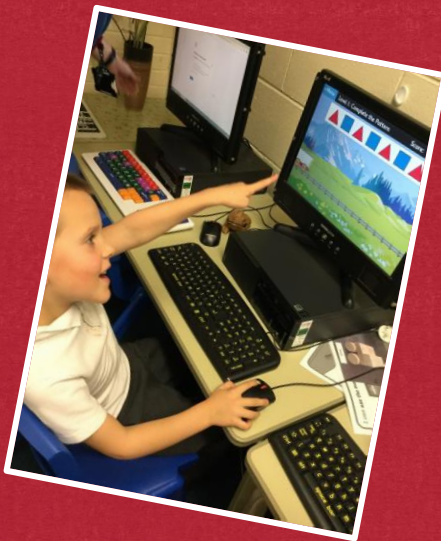

All children can access all 3 class bases and outside areas

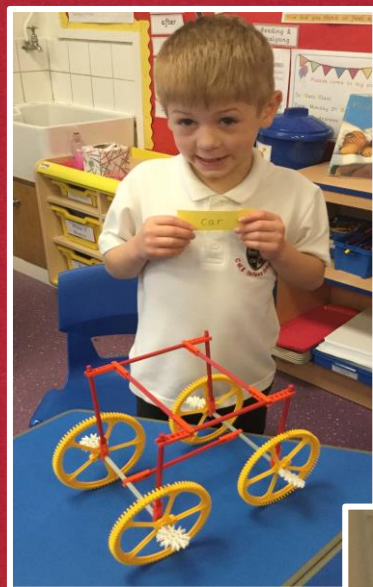
Year 1

Children start the National Curriculum in Year 1

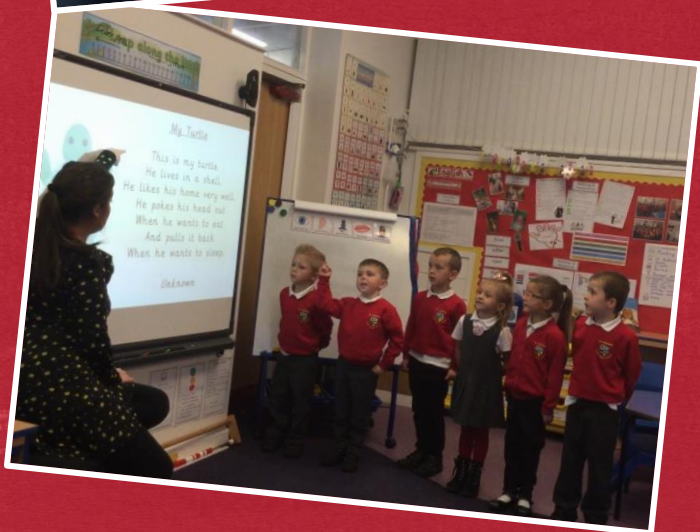

Children follow an enriched curriculum with a strong sense of enquiry at its heart that is led by the children's interests.

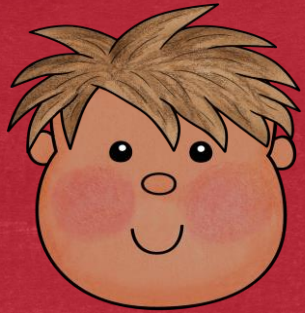


It is full of opportunity to excel in art, craft and a chance to produce some unique pieces of work

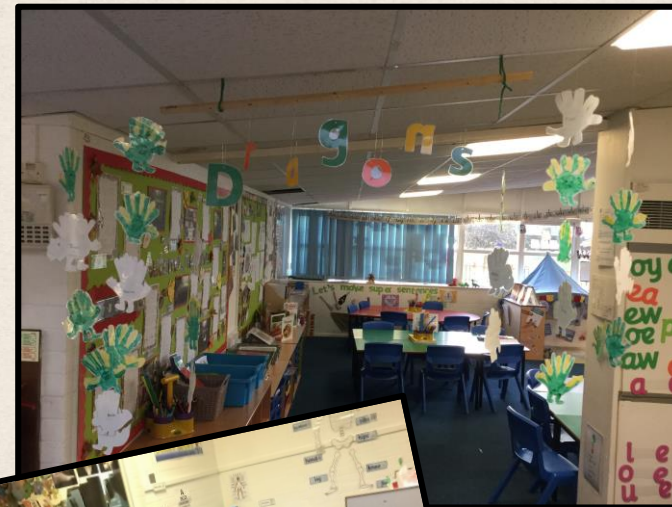


Children work in class supported by teachers and teaching assistants and out of class in small groups

Our lessons are varied and cover all National Curriculum subjects. Computing, music and P.E are some of our favourites



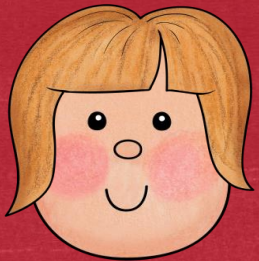
